Must be member in Good Standing for 5 years or 3 years with one year service on another committee. Review professional standards complaints. Acts as probable cause panel.
- Professional Standards**
(monthly if needed)
Must have served 3 years on Grievance Committee. Acts as hearing panel for cases. Meeting attendance critical.
